

Hån Vemdalens fishing district.

Our district stretches from south to north from the village of Vemhån till Henvålen and from west to east from the river Ljusnan till the border of Härjedalen with Jämtland.

Vemhån, Björnrike, Vemdalen and Vemdalsaskalet are well known destinations with good facilities for tourism. For those of you who like to angle in streaming water there are three rivers at your disposal, the Veman, the Ljusnan and the Alopnan. The Veman is a unique unregulated river, the artery of a long stretched valley, of which large parts can easily be approached from the main roads. The Veman offers anglers outstanding opportunities and is well known for fishing on grayling.

The Ljusnan in the west has perfect spots for fishing on trout and grayling, but you can also catch pikes, perches and lake whitefish here. The Alopnan is an exciting and beautiful wilderness creek high in the mountain heathlands, approachable after a tough stroll. You can angle there on grayling and trout, but also on pikes who drag along there from the nearby Håsjön lake. In this area you will find many brooks in which you can catch trout.

During the winter season we are snow-clearing the roads to a number of large lakes and forest lakes. Many other lakes can be reached by snow scooter. We are closely cooperating with our neighboring fishing districts, who offer even more opportunities for splendid nature- and fishing experiences.
